Sorting coupons by "color"

Those who have participated in the coupon program in past years know that you have to separate your coupons first by Market PIN and then by color. Unfortunately, this year, after printing, we observed that the two colors for the WIC and Senior coupons were remarkably close. You may find this chart helpful during the sorting process.
